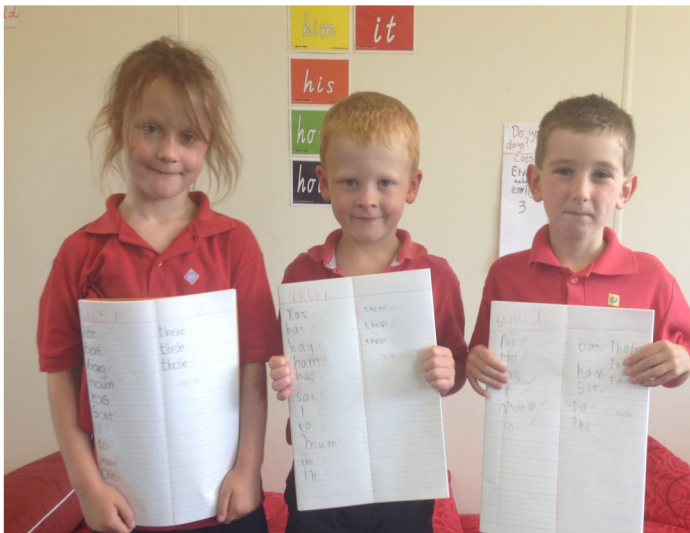

## EDUCATION MAINTENANCE ALLOWANCE

In 2014, the EMA payments to eligible parents will be:

- \$200 for parents of eligible Prep students
- \$150 for parents of all other eligible primary school students

The EMA is paid in two instalments annually (70% in March and 30% in August).

To be eligible for the EMA:

1. Your child must be under the age of sixteen and;
2. Your child must be enrolled at a primary or registered school in Victoria on, 28th February 2014 for the first instalment and 1st August 2014 for the second instalment and;
3. You must on 28th January 2014 for the first instalment and 14th July 2014, for the second instalment:
  - Be parent or legal guardian of the student; and
  - Be an eligible beneficiary within the meaning of the State Concessions Act 2004, that is, be a holder of Veterans Affairs Gold Card or be an eligible Health Care Card (HCC) or Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) holder or
  - Be a temporary foster parent.
4. Submit your application to the school by the due date:
  - 28th February 2014 for the first instalment\*
  - 1st August 2014 for the second instalment

\*Please note: you only need to make a second application in August if your child changes schools between March and August.

The Pension Concession Card (PCC0 or Health Care Card (HCC) is subject to electronic confirmation with Centrelink to verify that the cardholder is receiving a benefit.

Application form for EMA was sent home last week. **Please note that we need to copy your relevant Centrelink Card for our records.** Although you have until **February 28th** to apply for this allowance, the sooner we receive this, the sooner we can commence the process via the EMA website.

## MOYSTON LIBRARY

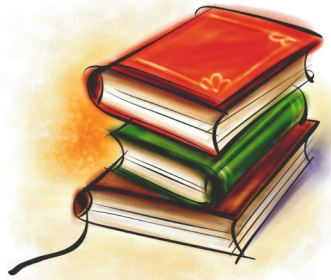
New weekly Outreach service for Moyston.
