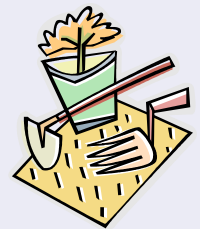
Johnston and Marshall families are rostered to help in the kitchen tonight. Please arrange a swap if this isn't convenient.

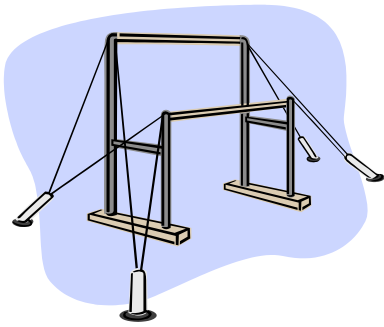
