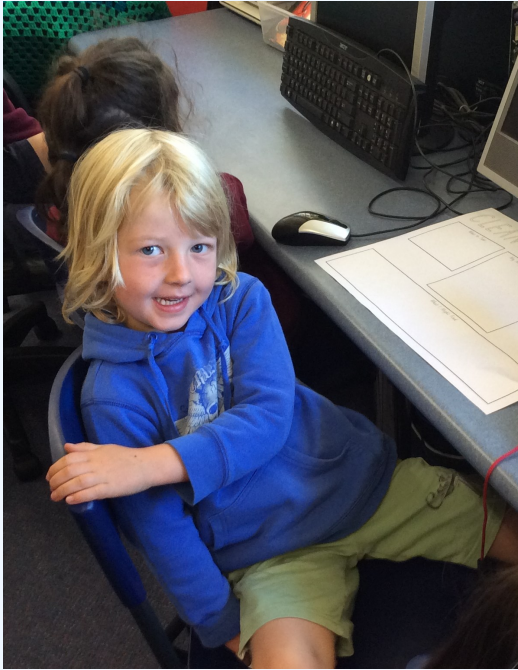
SCHOOL COUNCIL
