
Today was the last of the 4 sessions, next Friday will be our Cluster Day at Buangor Primary School.

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

From March 1st 2014, the Education Department has procedures in place to support amendments to the *Education & Training Reform Act 2006* in relation to the enforcement of compulsory school enrolment and attendance.

Where a student has been absent from school on at least five full days in the previous 12 months, the parent has not provided a reasonable excuse for these absences and measures to improve the student's attendance have been undertaken & been unsuccessful, or are inappropriate in the circumstances, principles can exercise their discretion to refer the matter to a School Attendance Officer for further action. These officers can then issue a School Attendance Notice to the parent giving the opportunity to provide a reasonable excuse for the absences or, where necessary, nominate the parent responsible for the absences. Failure to comply with this Notice may result in the issue of an Infringement Notice, which carries with it a penalty of approximately \$70.


