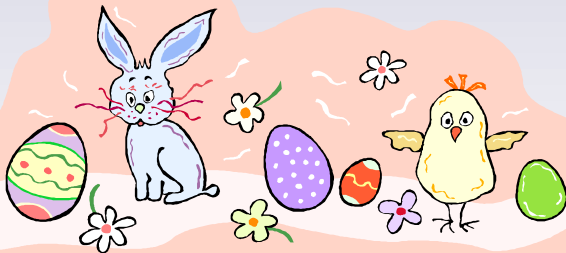

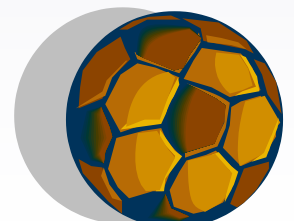
## **ACTIVE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM**
