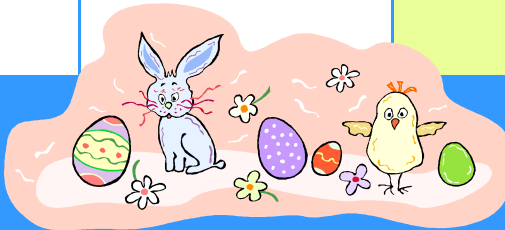

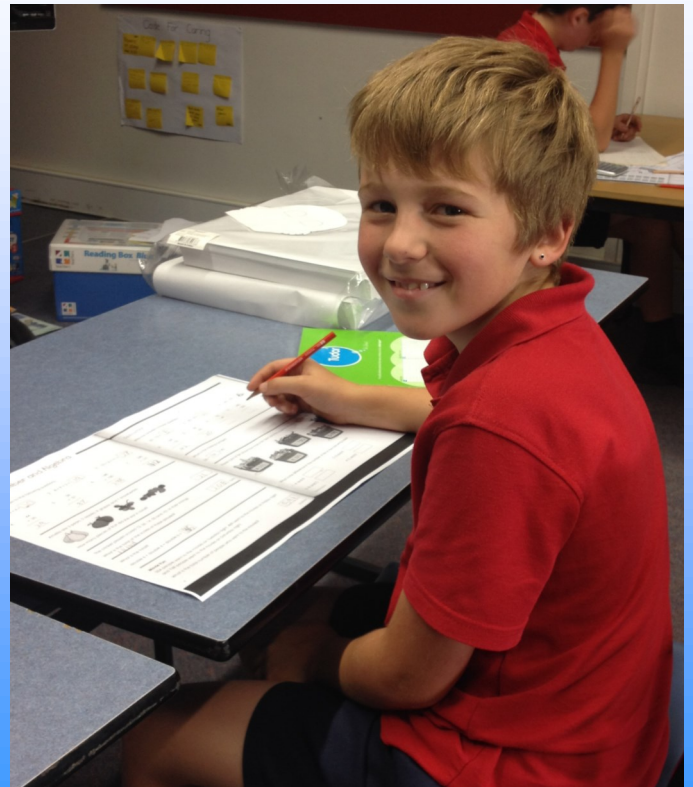

All you have to do is hand your old Mobile Phone handset into the school and we will donate \$2. Please make sure you do a **FACTORY RESET** on your mobile phone so to ensure your personal details/photos/text messages/phone numbers are wiped off your phone. HOW ARE PHONES RECYCLED?

The mobile phones once collected are sorted into parts:-



Batteries are sorted by Chemistry (Lithium ion, Alkaline & Ni-Cad) and then sent off shore to extract the reusable minerals and metals.



Mobile Phones are broken down into three parts.

- **Circuit Boards** are exported by precious metal type.
- **Plastics** from the hand sets are reused as fence posts, seats and flooring.
- **Screens** are crushed and then exported for rare earth mineral extraction.
- **Mobile Phone Accessories.** The power supplies are broken down. The Copper is reclaimed and reused as power cables and the plastic is used for fence posts, seats and flooring.

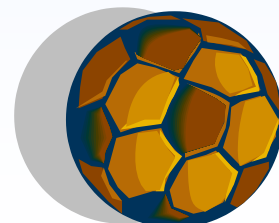
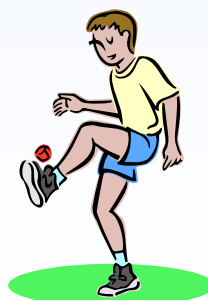
ACTIVE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM TERM 2

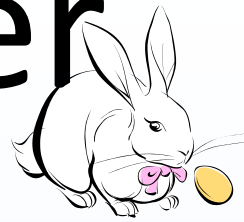
The Active After School program has been a huge success this term. The children have had a great time learning many new skills and staying fit and active.

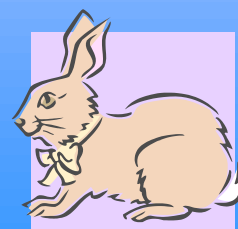
