






Today we travelled to Maroona Primary School for a Science Discovery Cluster day.

The Moyston and District School sports will be held at Pomonal on **Friday 16th May**.

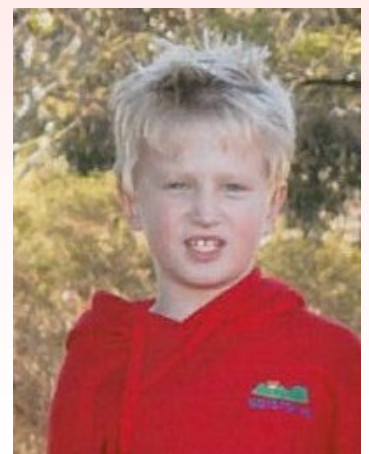
The children have been practising for the sports with Mrs White and are looking forward to the day.

Personalised order envelopes will be forwarded home prior to that date. Students are expected to wear their full school uniform.

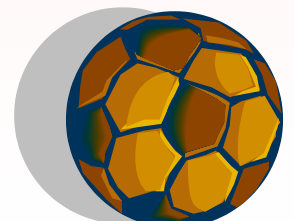
ACTIVE AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM TERM 2

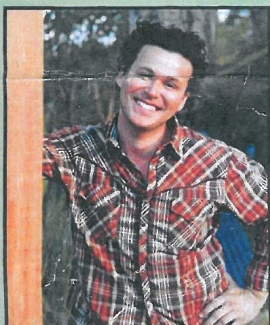

Horse ride will once again be held in Moyston and the school has been asked to cater a dinner. This has been a fantastic fundraiser in previous years.

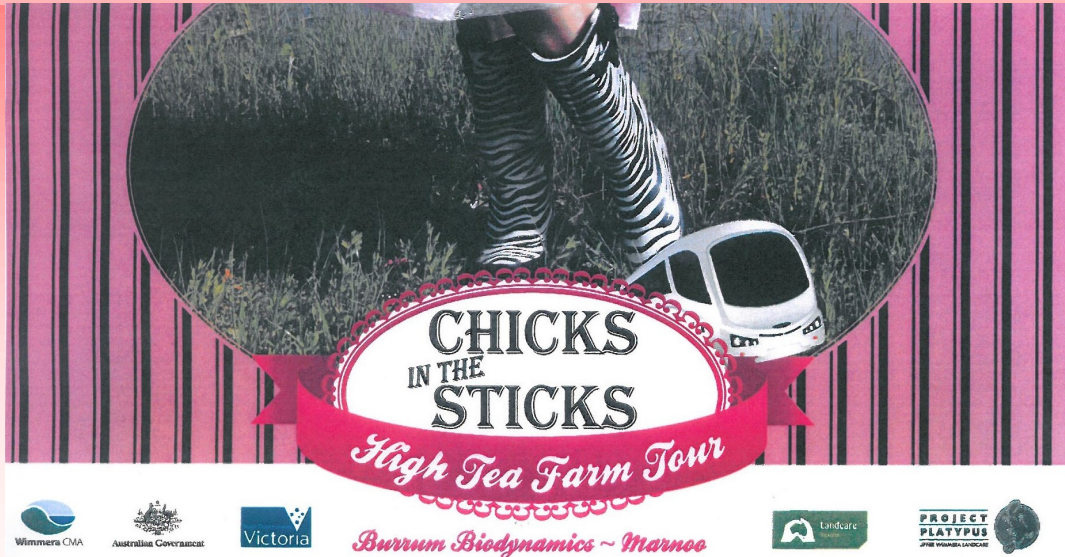
The menu is casserole dishes, we may need to borrow some slow cookers. We will need at least 4-5 people to help on the night. Keep an eye on the blackboard for more information.
