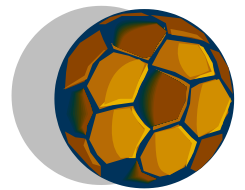

PORTABLE REDEVELOPMENT

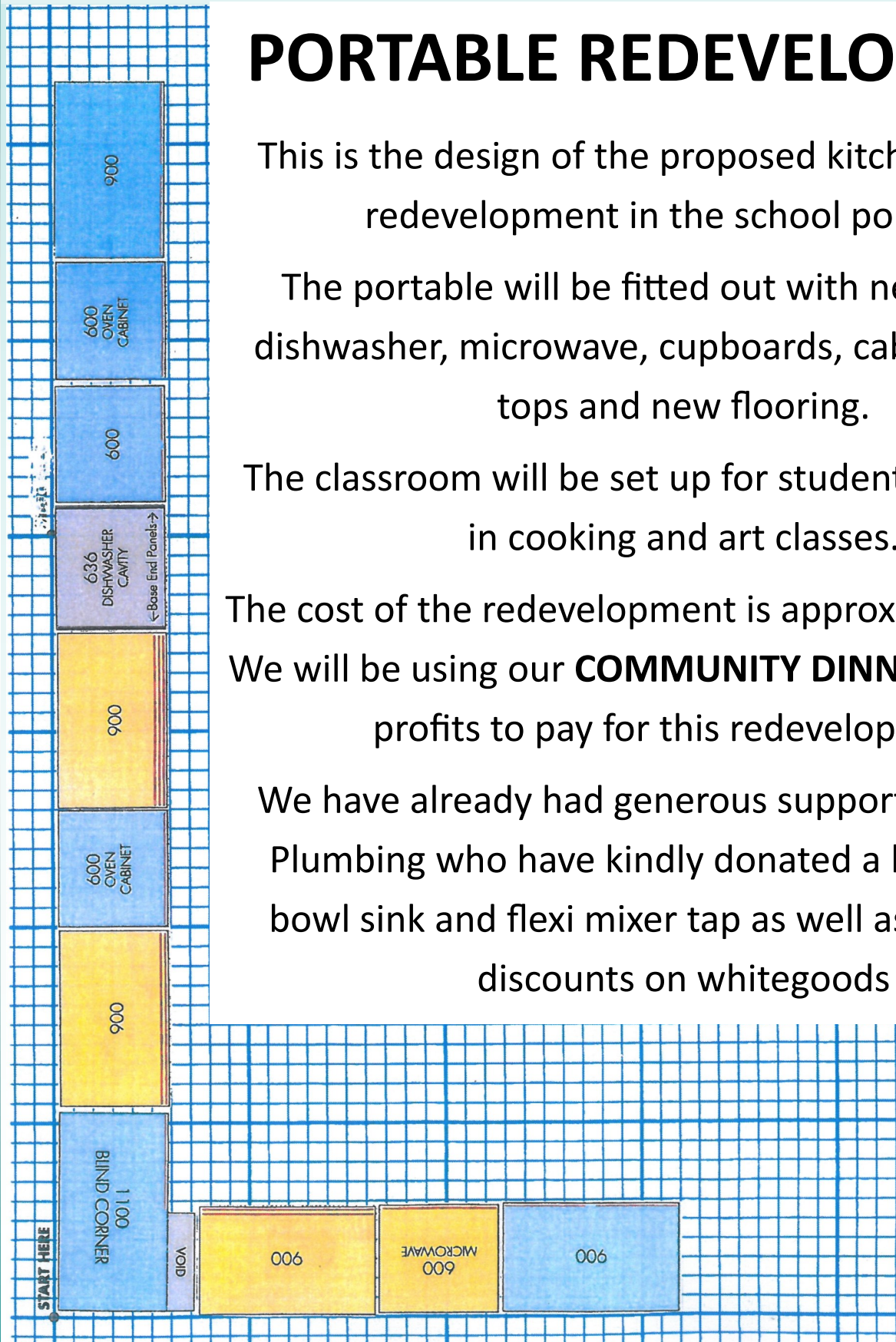
This is the design of the proposed kitchen/art room redevelopment in the school portable.
