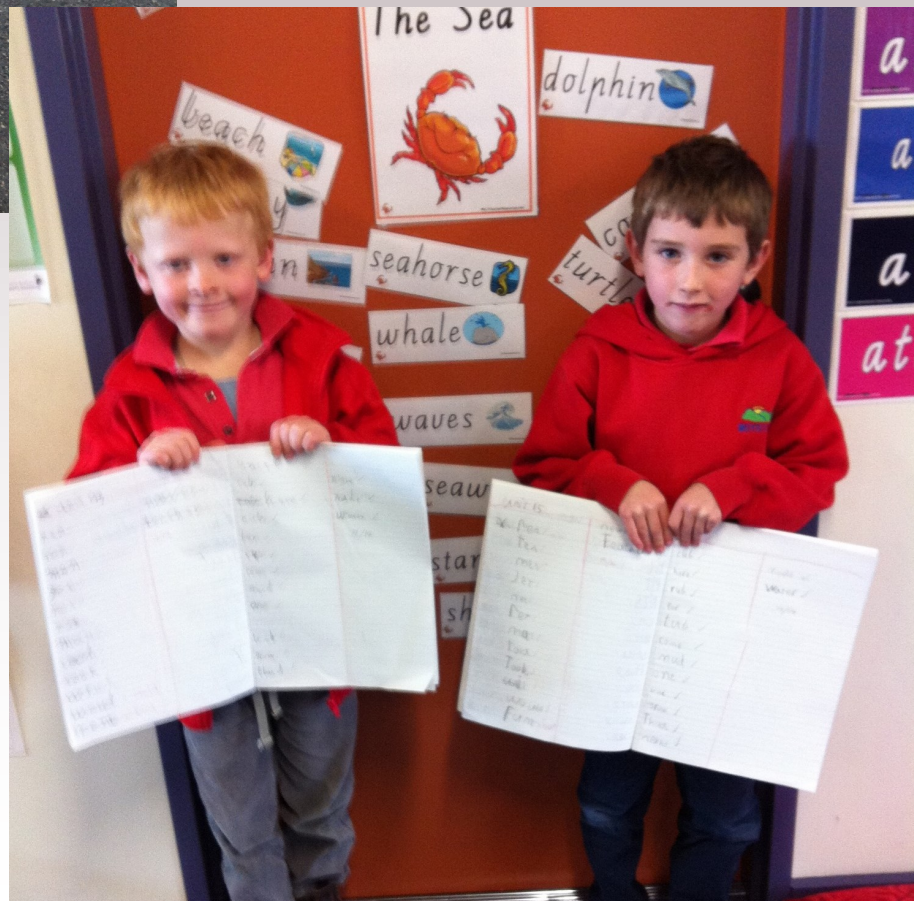

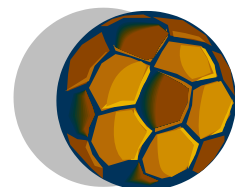

Please contact us on **1300 073 639** to make an appointment for you child/children. We would appreciate your response as soon as possible as appointments close Monday 4th August 2014.

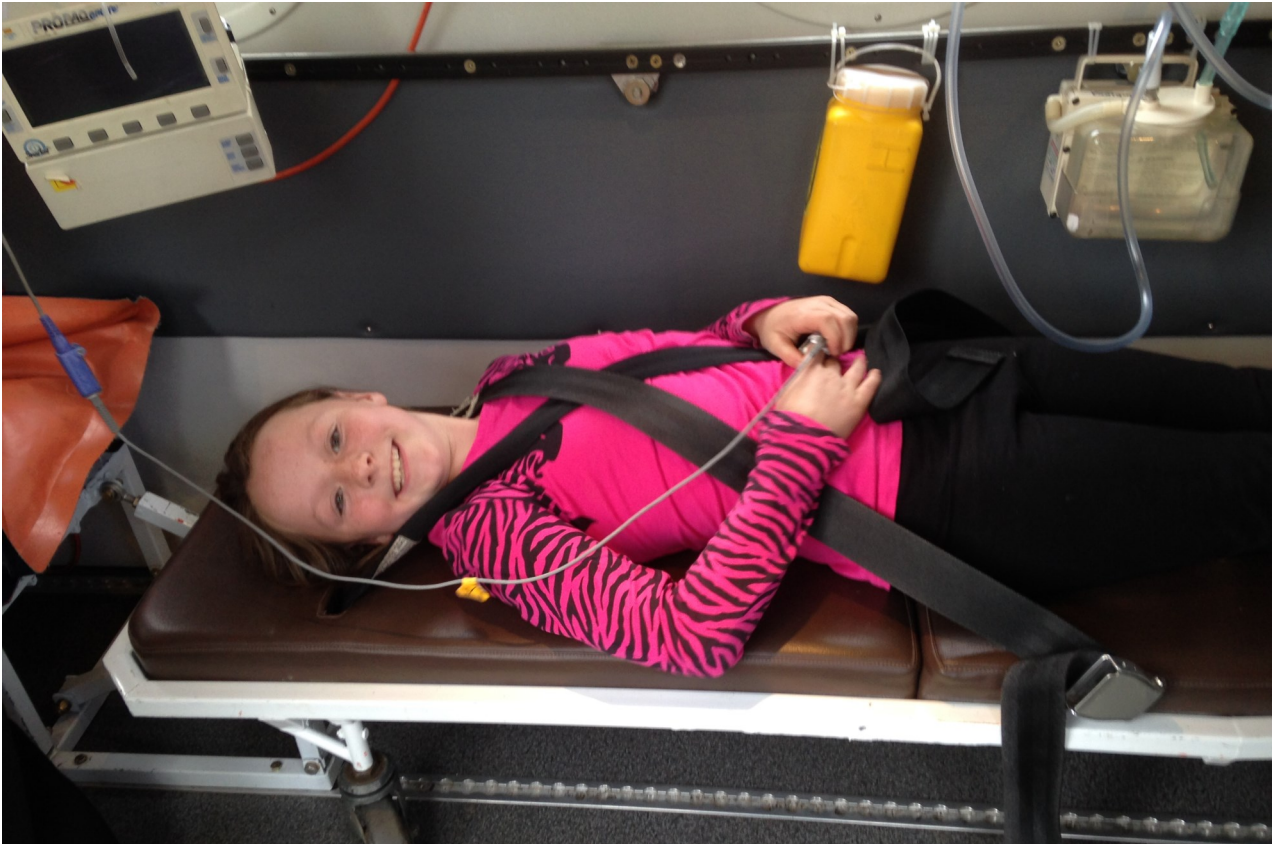
***Please note that a parent/guardian must be present during the appointment and you need to inform Kendra or Anthony when your child will be absent in class for their appointment.**

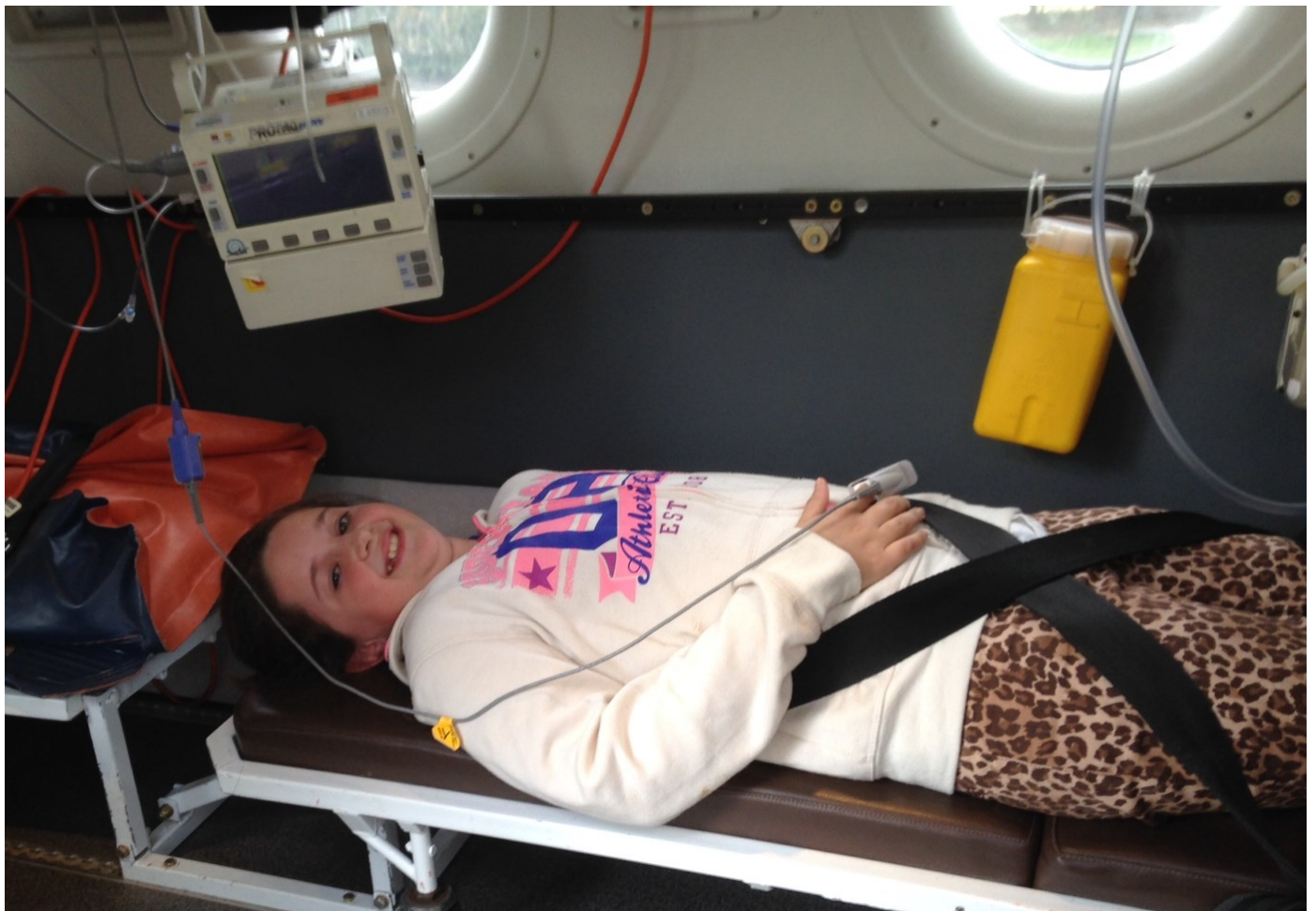
