
Once we returned to school we farewelled our Chinese visitors Jane, Lisa and Jim after their 2 week visit to Moyston Primary School.

A note has been forwarded home with further information.





We welcome parents in both the Prep-Grade 2 room and the Grade 3-6 room.


The students really enjoy
