Well done and good luck in Warrnambool tomorrow!




## PET RESPONSIBILITY

### Make a Poppy Workshop - 11am Tuesday 30th September


Jade will guide you through the process of using felt to make poppies to contribute to the 5000 Poppies project which commemorates the Anzac Centenary. Anyone can join in.

Are continuing throughout the holiday period. Baby Rhyme Time on Tuesdays 10am and Story time on Thursday at 11am.




