It is a four day, three night camp from Tuesday November 11th to Friday November 14th 2014.

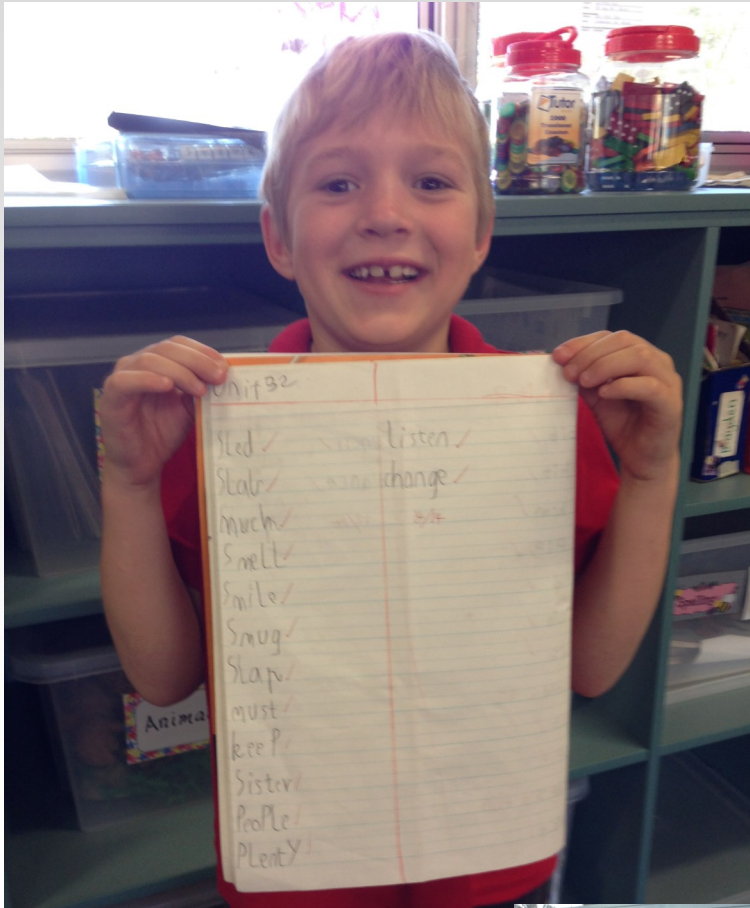
Further details have been sent home to families.
