School Fees Early Bird discount

\$120 First child, \$100 2nd child, \$80 3rd child, 4th child FREE. **Early bird discount on first child if paid before END OF TERM 1.**

The school levy covers all books, pens, paper, library fee and some excursions.

Families are also able to make a lump sum payment to the amount of their choosing e.g. \$300 at any time. Lyn can then deduct fees, uniform, excursions and any other charges from the balance as they arise.

16km Farm to Pub

*** New course in 2015!!! ***

Bus departs Pub @ 3.30pm (so 3.15pm arrival)
First runners depart farm at 4.00pm. Riders @ 4.30pm.

- Riders own responsibility to get their bikes to the start line.

To get to the start line:

- Drive 6.3kms out on Delacombe Way - Turn left on Malim Rd, drive for 4.8kms - Bendigo Bank marque will be situated here

8.5km Farm to Pub (Run & Ride)

With the new course, makes life easier so no need to catch a bus, with the start at pub, with the course being a loop to get back there.

4.30pm start for the runners, 4.45pm for the riders.

4.30 pm—Bus departs 4.20pm

Entries close - 5pm Tuesday 24th of March.

Entry fee is \$15, with ith being \$5 for 15 & under.

Note - Entries for all categories will be allowed on race day, however only as fun runners (time not captured & results not official)

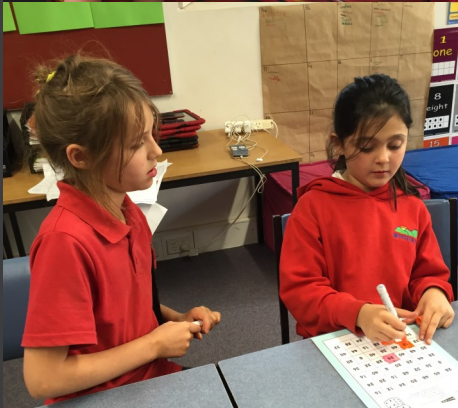

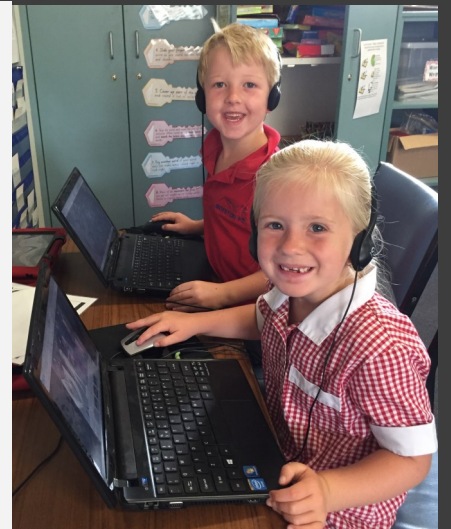


COMMUNITY DINNER ROSTER

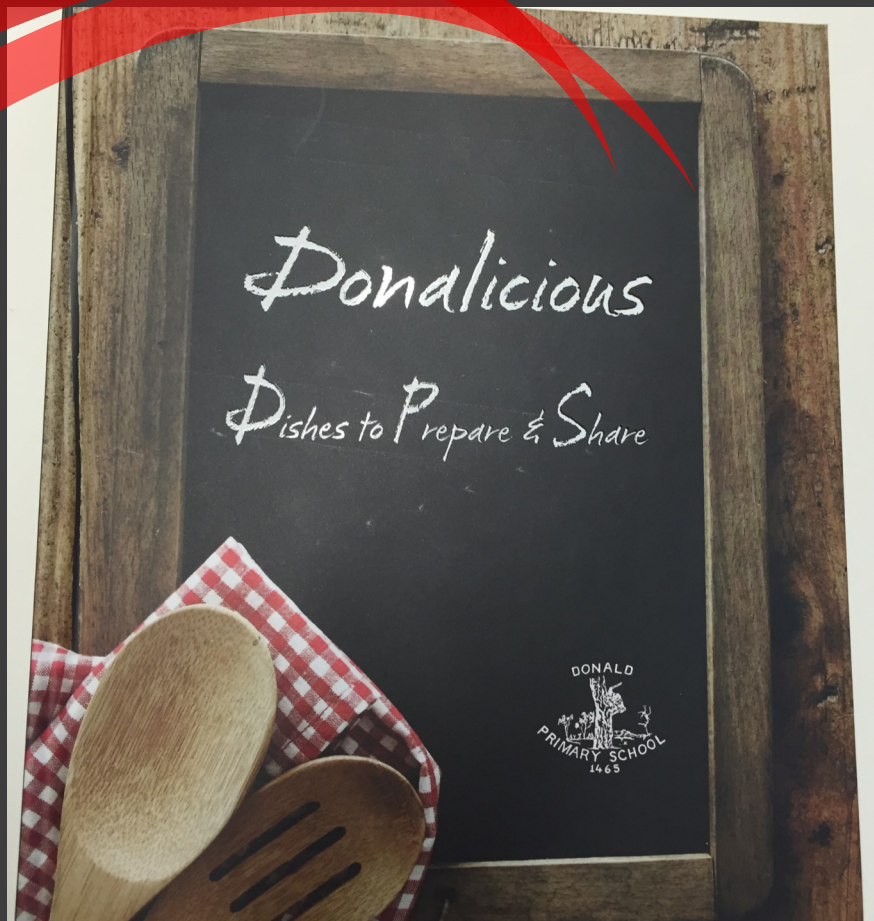
The Moyston Community Dinners is the major fundraising event for Moyston PS.
