Students completed a research project of their choice and chose a variety of ways to present their learning, ranging from PowerPoint presentations to dioramas.






FATHER'S DAY STALL




WOOLWORTHS EARN AND LEARN HAS FINISHED!

Anthony has been working hard in the 'new' Sports Shed. The original shed at the school is in the process of getting an internal transformation and will be storing all our sports equipment.






COMMUNITY DINNER
