The raffle will be drawn on Thursday 10th December at the end of year break up.

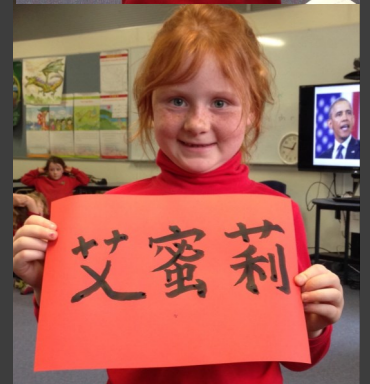


The Junior classroom have been enjoying reading Mr Men books this term, and writing their own stories based on the books.
