Our students performed incredibly well at the School Sports this year. Moyston PS were the winners of the Team Events!



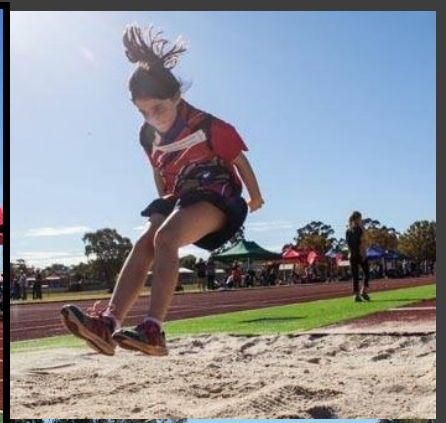
The teamwork, encouragement and resilience of the students was fantastic to see.
