


Last Friday saw our students and families travel to Hoppers Crossing to the Wyndham Warriors BMX track.

The weather was fantastic. It was a very successful day for our school. Only 1 week until our next event at Knox in Melbourne!









Our Chinese visitors got to experience lots of activities during their time with us. Terry and Tony enjoyed normal classroom routines with the students of Moyston Primary School.


They particularly enjoyed the BMX track as well as cooking, playing basketball and experimental coding with our robotic ball Sphero.








EGHS DENTAL VISIT

Our students learnt about dental health and what to expect when you go to the dentist for a check-up.





WORKING BEE

Thank you to our helpers who came to our recent working bee.


All of our school bikes were cleaned and prepped for our first BMX race!




MOYSTON PS ACHIEVEMENTS
