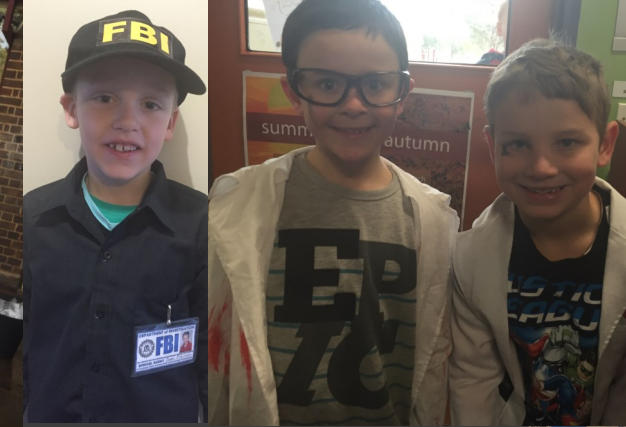
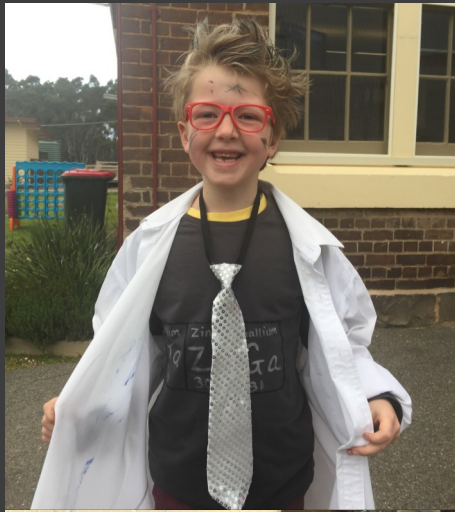

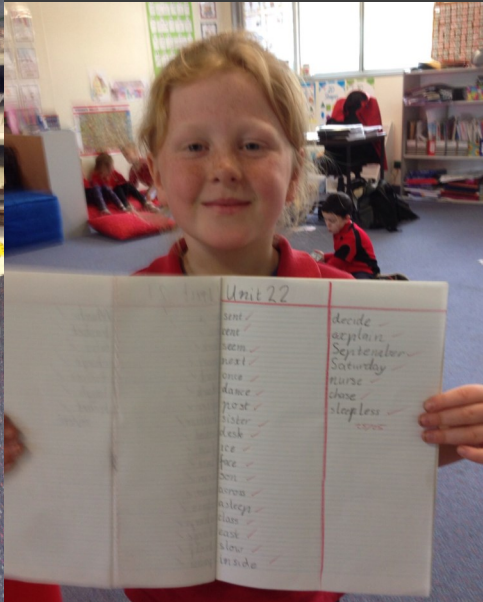
**SCIENCE DAY!**
