


Our students (and their families) have put in an outstanding amount of effort this year making it another very successful BMX season for Moyston Primary School!

For those staying in Bendigo, we are also planning to go out as a school group for tea on Thursday night at 6pm, further details will be made available next week.






TRANSPORT




