For those staying in Bendigo, we are also planning to go out as a school group for tea on Thursday night at 6pm, further details will be made available next week.










TRANSPORT

During Maths today, the senior students measured all of the angles in their names using protractors.






They then spent some time playing 'I Have, Who Has' measurement game.
