CRICKET

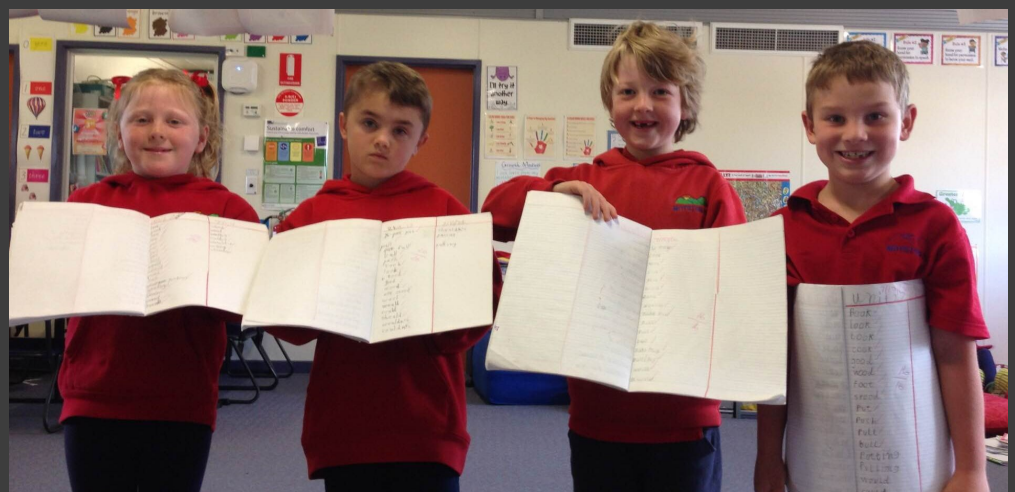
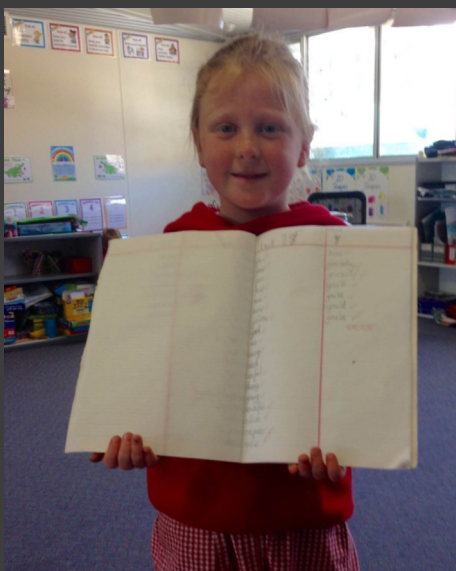
Yesterday we had a visit from Tristan from the Big Bash cricket team the Melbourne Renegades.

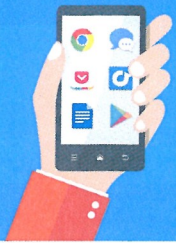

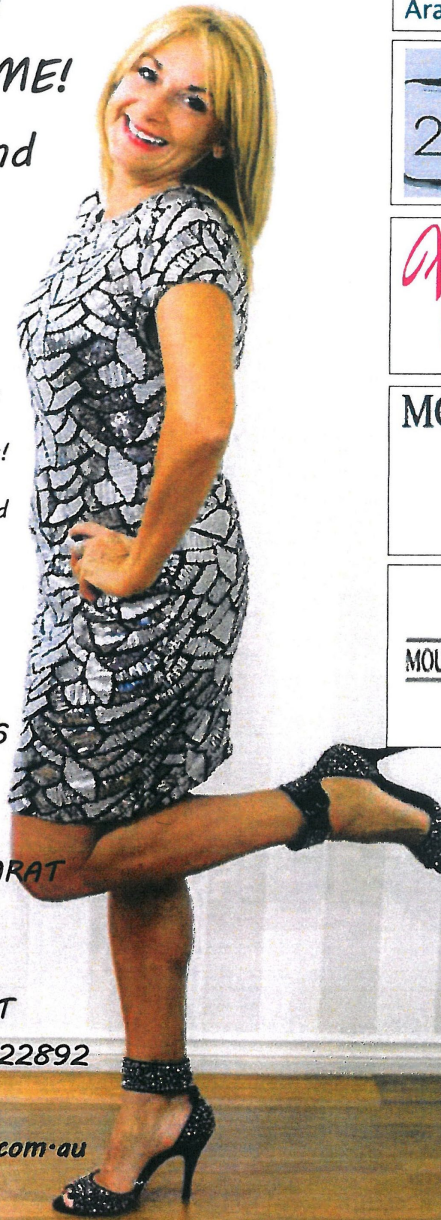
