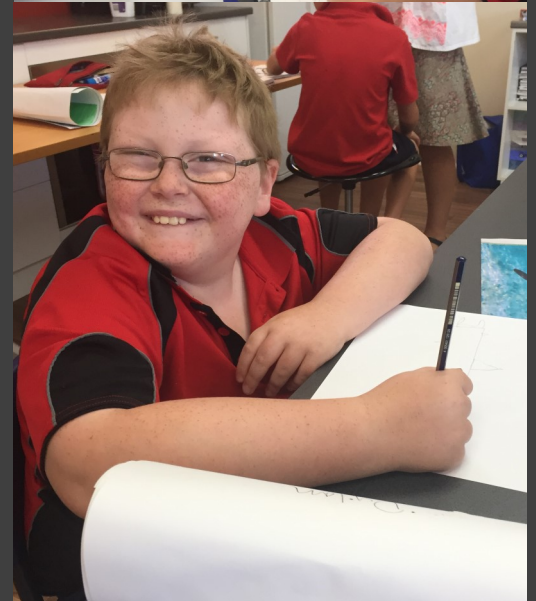
ART

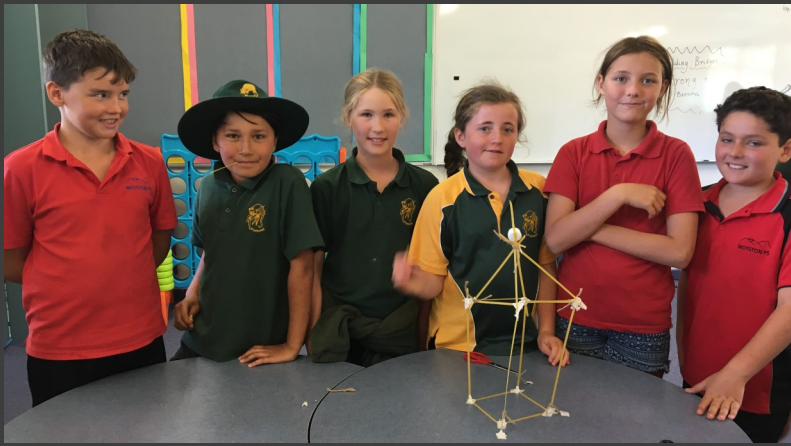

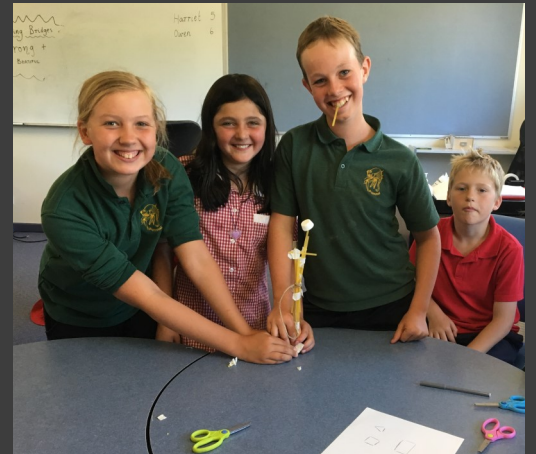
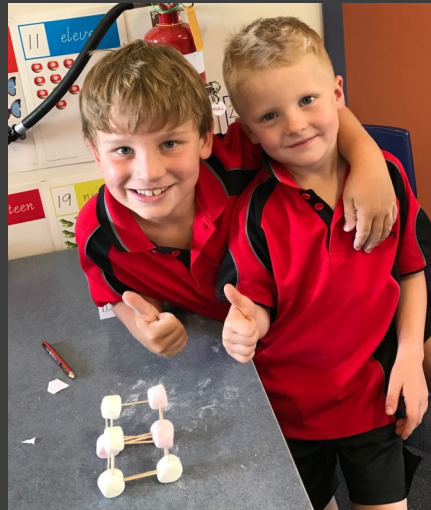
Issue 2 of Scholastic Book Club

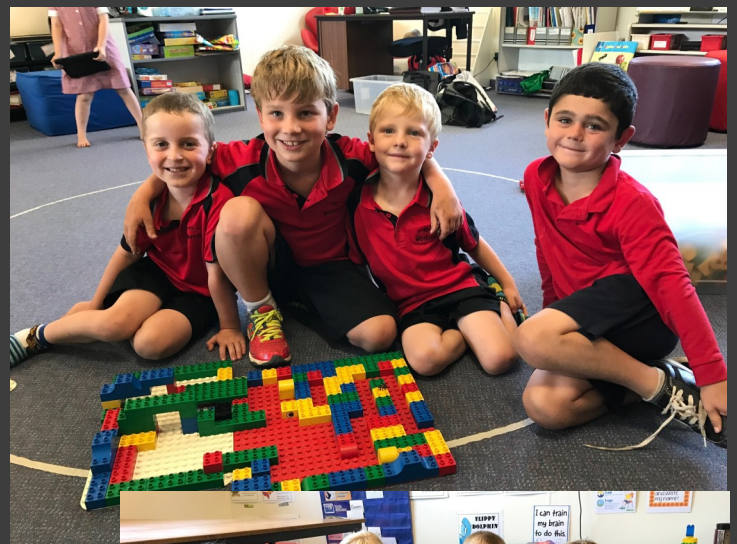
POMONAL VISIT
