










The latest STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering & Mathematics) challenge in the Junior room was to make 2D shapes using marshmallows and toothpicks!



Thanks also to Nadine for cooking preserves and the Spry family for their donation of plums!


There will also be a Moyston PS stall for jams and preserves at the Moyston Easter Market.
