LAKE FYANS BIKE RIDE

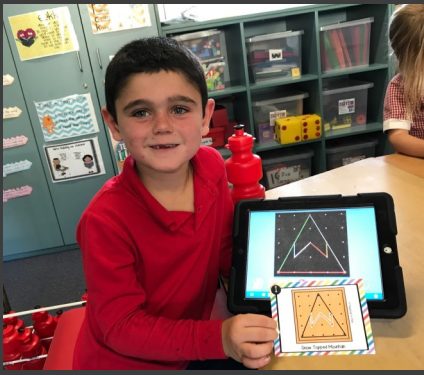

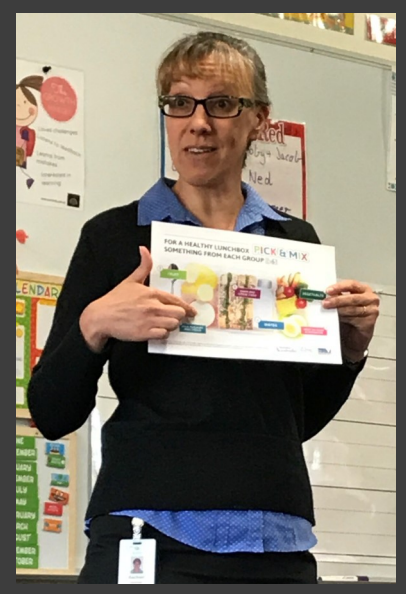
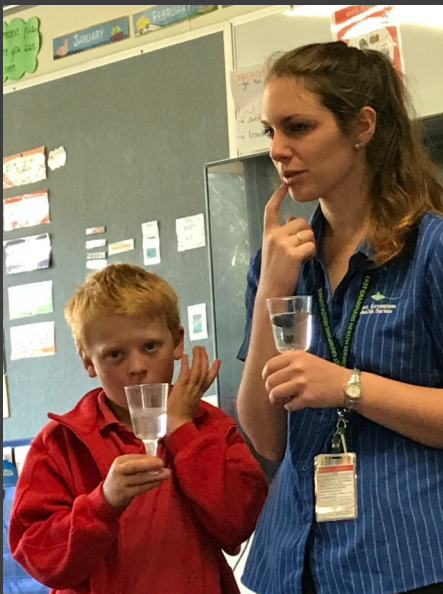
