## ART

Yesterday the students finished off their pencil cases that they have been making in Art. These pencil cases involved collecting materials, dyeing fabric, sewing, ironing and drawing!

# COOKING

This week the students worked in groups to bake different flavoured muffins. This activity required teamwork and some maths skills to ensure their measurements were correct.

2 eggs  
125ml vegetable oil  
250ml milk  
200g caster sugar  
400g self-raising flour  
1 tsp salt

We then added ingredients to make vanilla, banana or chocolate chip muffins.



# AT HOME TASKS THAT HELP MAKE MATHS PART OF EVERYDAY LIFE

Ask your children to get out the cups, plates and cutlery for a meal without telling them how many are needed.

Get the kids to work out how many minutes there are left until something happens (e.g. how long until your swimming lesson?) Both digital and analogue clocks are great for this.

Let the kids cook—particularly recipes involving measuring fractions of cups etc.

Look at maps of where you are going and let the kids try to follow the map while you get there. Find your street on a map.

When doing the groceries, ask the kids to collect numbers of items in the shop (e.g. 8 apples).
