AT HOME TASKS THAT HELP MAKE MATHS PART OF EVERYDAY LIFE

Talk about how things are similar and different (e.g. this one is pointy but this one is rounded), and classify the same group of objects in different way (colours, shapes, "pointy", "rough"....)

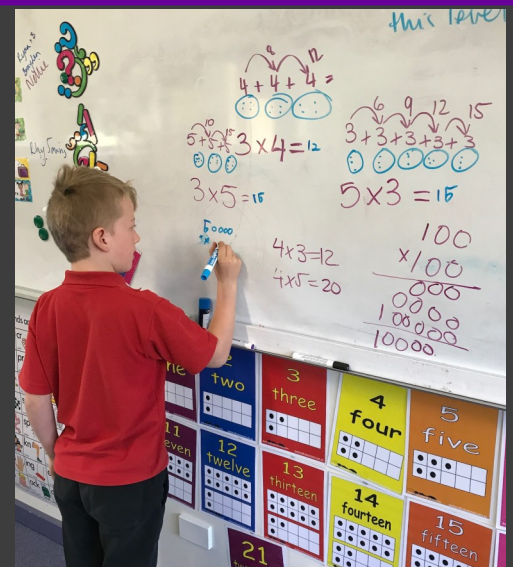
Share groups of objects or food between multiple kids (fairly).

Let your child work out the logistics for their birthday party (or dinner, camping trip etc.) How many cups, plates, packets of lollies? Timing (everyone will be here by 4pm so we will play games until 4.30pm and then serve cake. That will take 15 minutes. Then)

When on the highway, estimate how long it would take to get to the next town given the speed limit and distance.

Give them different sized cups to play with in the bath. Pour water form one to the other to compare which has the most.
