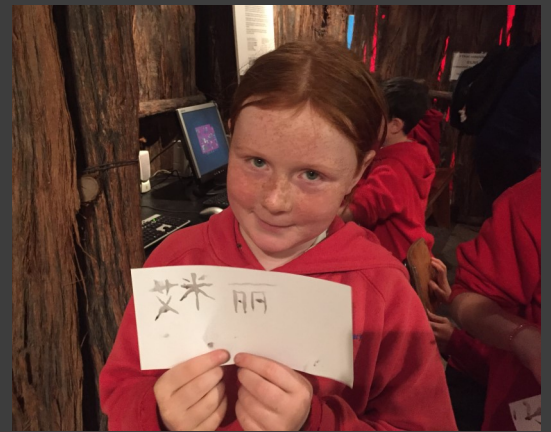
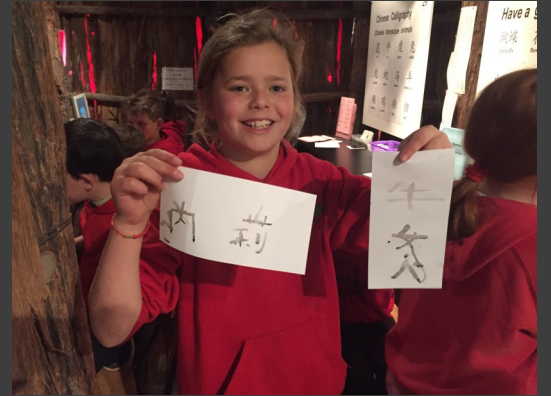


GUM SAN CHINESE HERITAGE CENTRE

Thank you to Grant Thomas who gave our students a very fun and informative tour around Ararat's Gum San Museum.



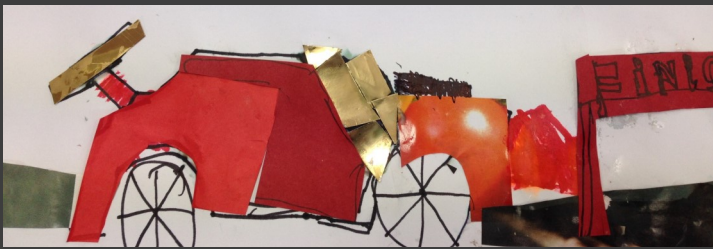

nets of different shapes to create their 3D robots.



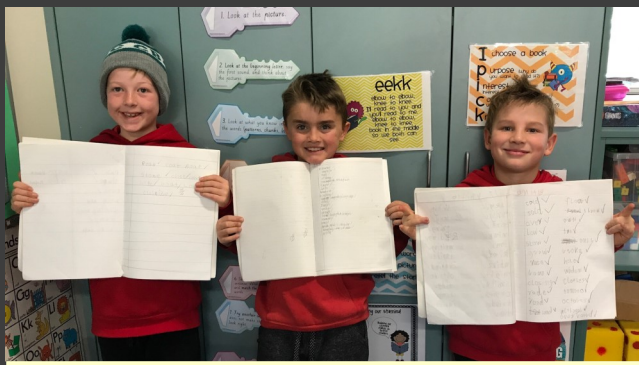


CLUSTER DAY AT BUANGOR

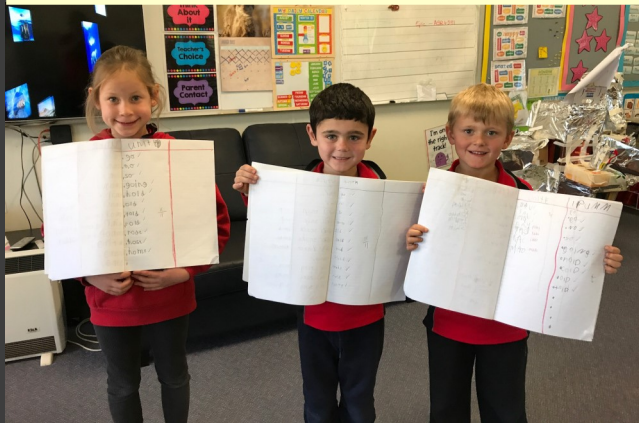
Our recent Cluster day was hosted by Buangor Primary School.

RESPECTING OTHERS

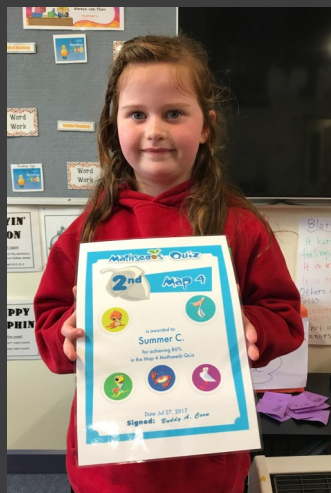
As part of our Bounce Back and Respectful Relationships program, we will be focussing on one individual character trait per week.
