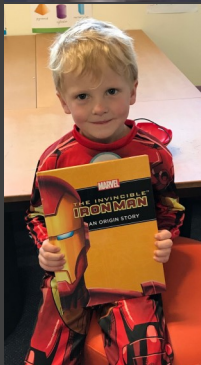

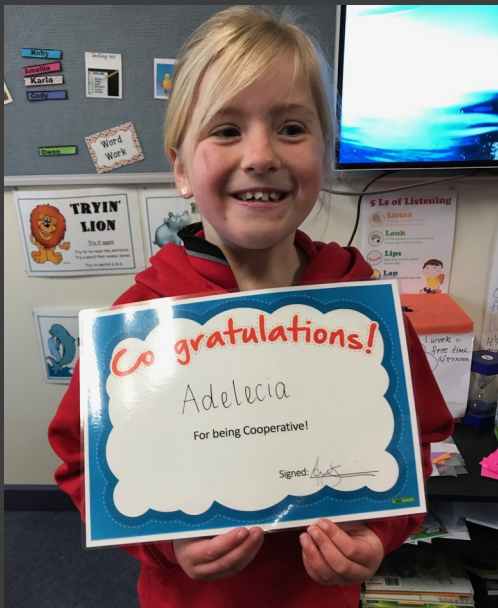

This week's awards was presented to Adelia for be Cooperative!

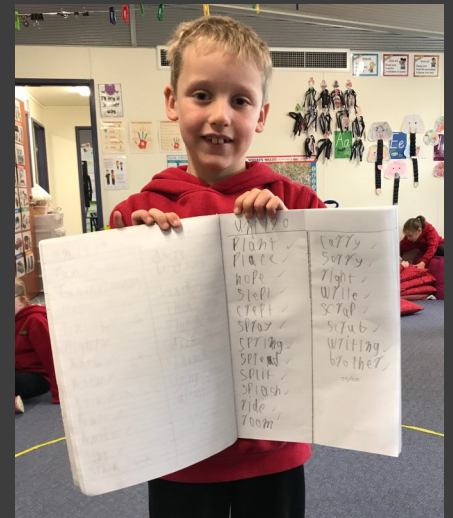
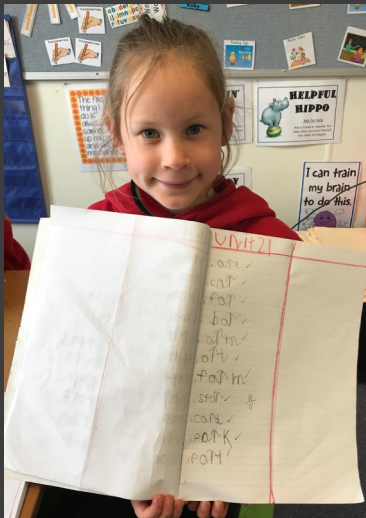
