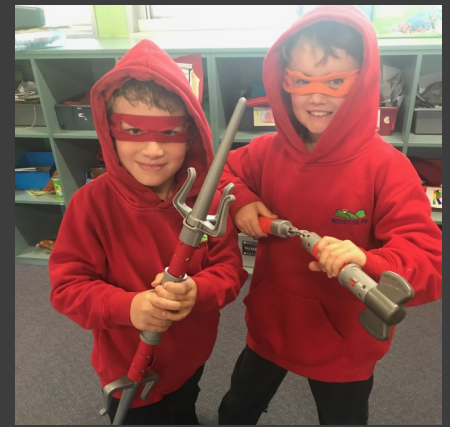
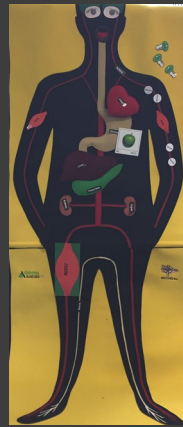
BMX WARRNAMBOOL THIS WEEKEND
