School council have subsidised \$100 per student for this camp.

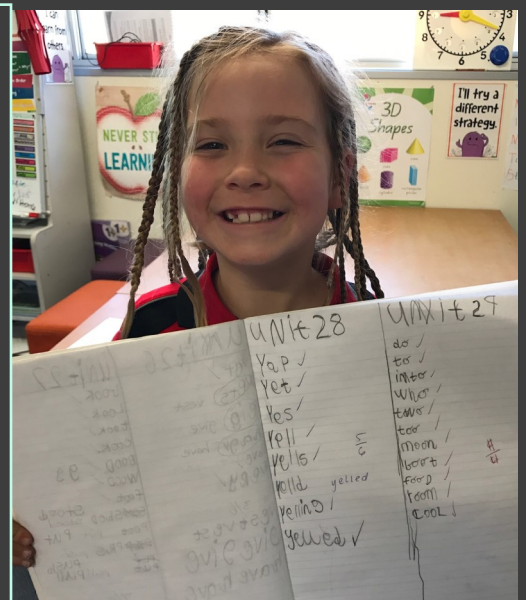
PREP—GRADE 2 EXCURSION & SCHOOL SLEEPOVER

Thank you to all of our helpers for setting up, cooking, serving and cleaning up on the night.



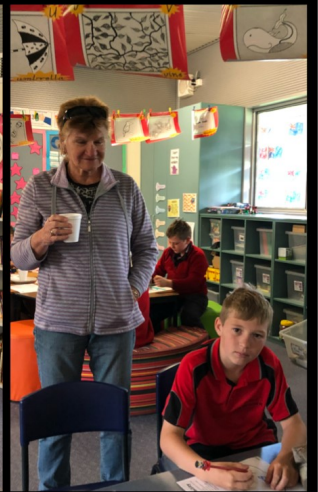
DONATION TO ARARAT WEST
