Please note that this is a CASH ONLY Book Fair.



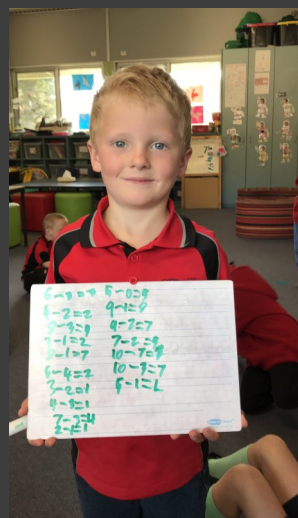
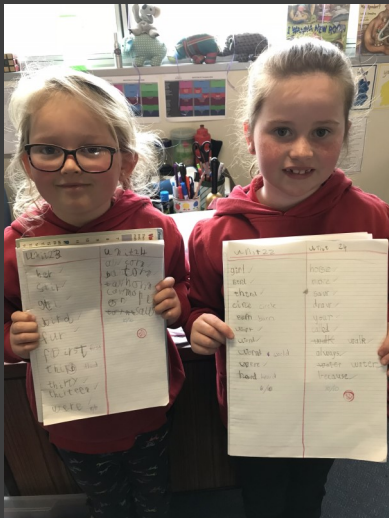

There were lots of medals awarded to our students at the end of the day! Great riding by all involved, well done!

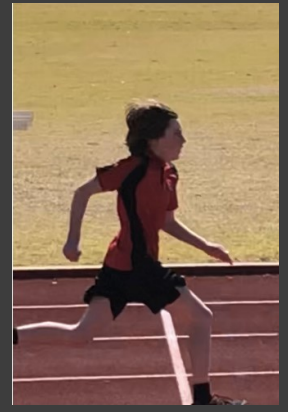




BLACK RANGES ATHLETICS
