Lauren is relocating to Geelong and has gained a position at Dean's Marsh Primary School.

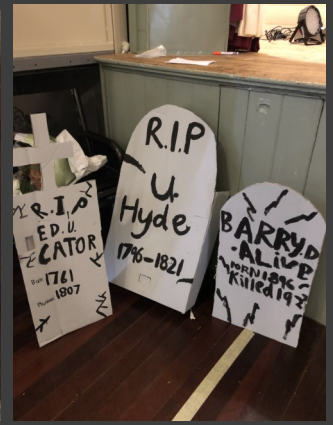
We would like to thank Lauren for everything she has done for Moyston PS! We wish her all the very best with her new role and we will miss her very much!

Unfortunately our Swimming Sports has to be cancelled due to the Fitness Centre double booking the pool.

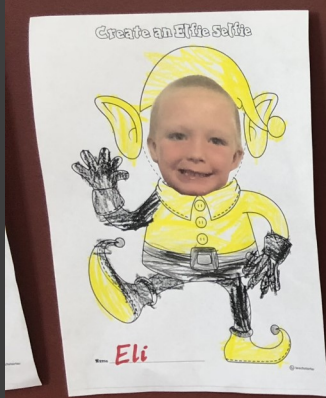
The swimming sports will now take place early in Term 1 2019.



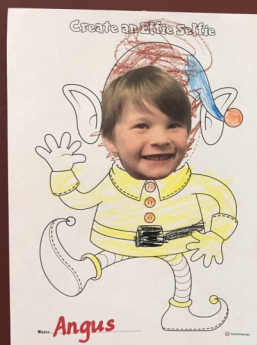


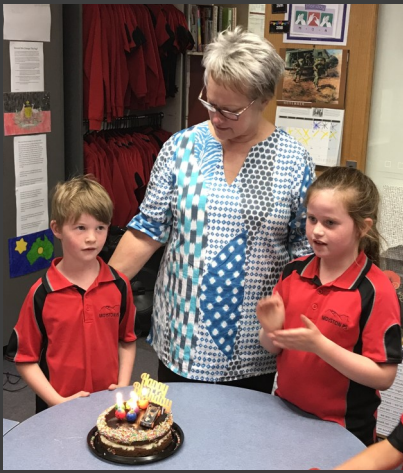
