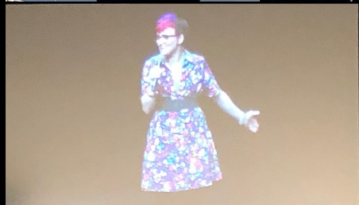


NATIONAL YOUNG LEADERS DAY
