The school is seeking donations of plastic bottle tops for yard projects please!

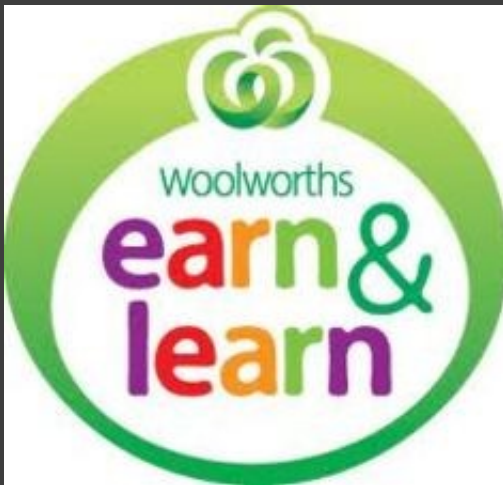


GUMBOOTS
