## HAPPY BIRTHDAY!

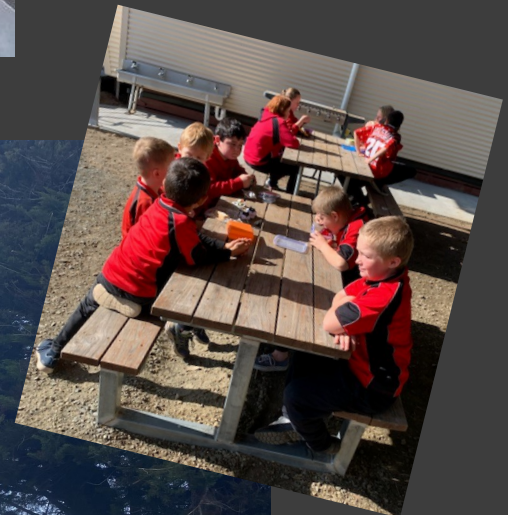
What a great impromptu lesson which was a perfect way to start our fractions unit!

Happy Birthday also to Lilli who celebrated her special day at the end of last term!

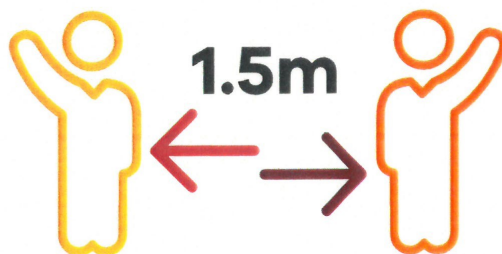


# CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) RESTRICTIONS REMAIN IN PLACE
