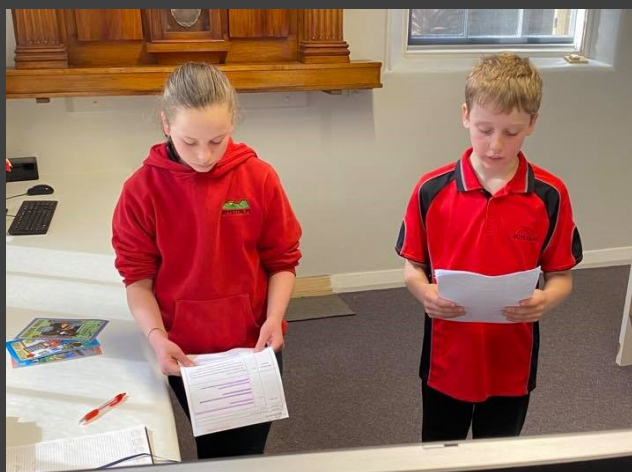
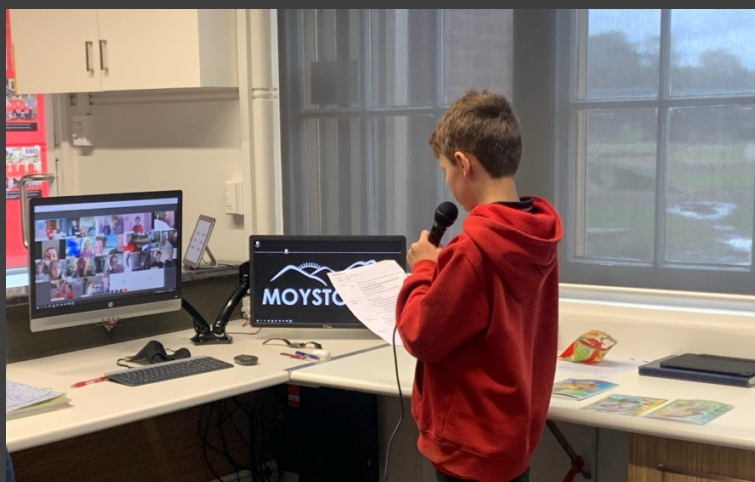

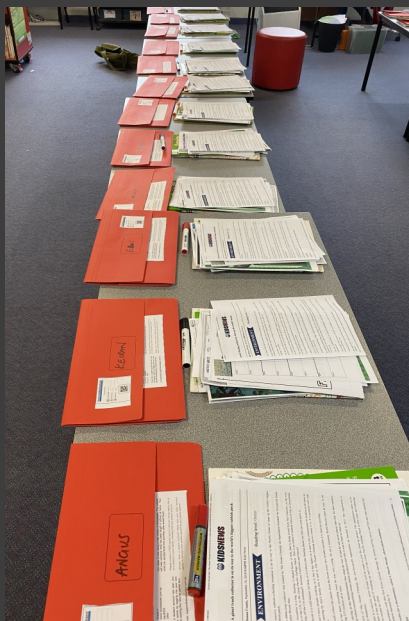
On-site supervision is available for students in the following categories:

- children whose parents cannot work from home and where no other supervision arrangements can be made (not only those defined as permitted workers)
- vulnerable children including:
 - children in out-of-home care
 - children deemed by Child Protection and/or Family Services to be at risk of harm
 - children identified by the school as vulnerable (including via referral from a family violence agency, homelessness or youth justice service or mental health or other health service).
- any child with a disability.

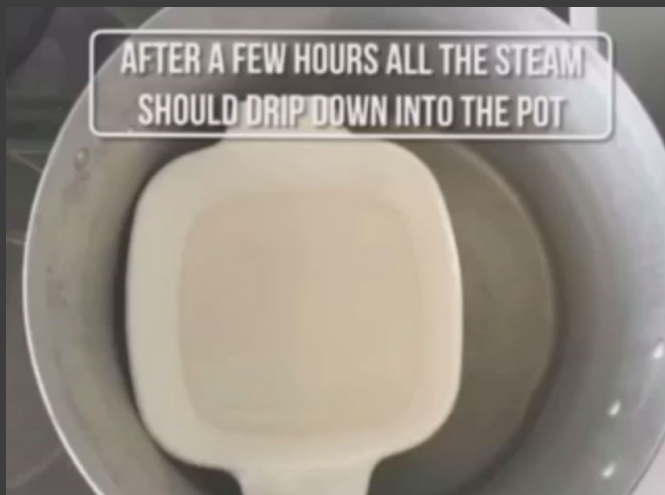
SCIENCE WEEK WATER CHALLENGE!

There are four things we must create to help us survive.

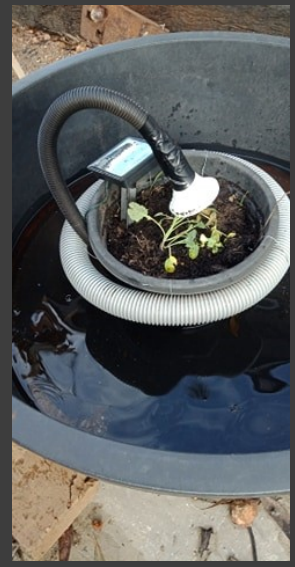


Make a water purifier that removes salt from water. We cannot survive without fresh water!

Design a floating fish farm. We are living on water, I hear you say? I know plenty of fishermen that can go for days without catching a thing! You won't be able to feed a family on air!

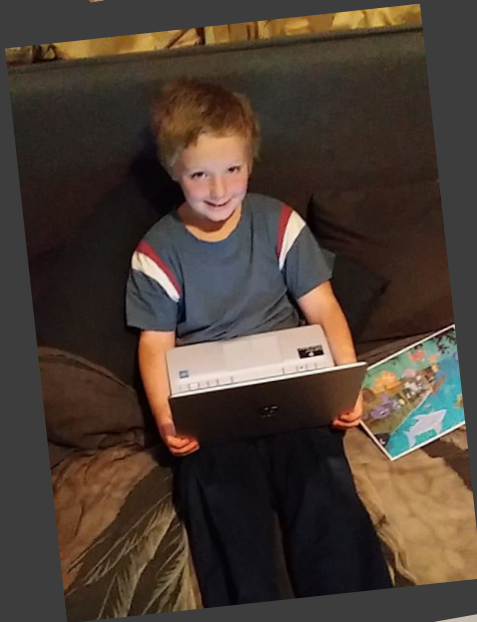
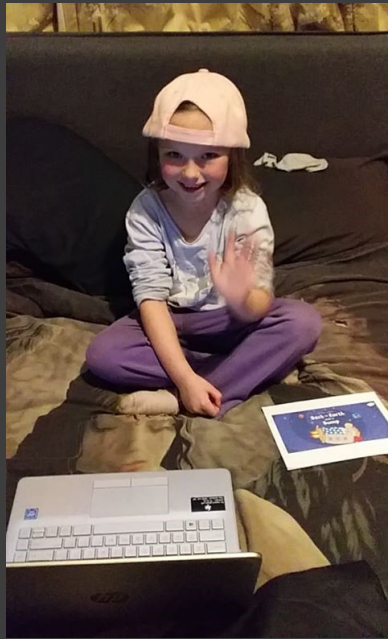


Create a mini floating garden. Fresh fish is lovely but salad and vegetables would be a welcome change and healthy option.



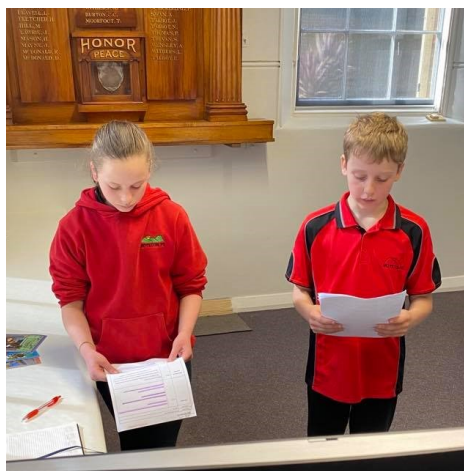
Make a raft that can hold your weight. We need to check fish farm, gardens and harvest water to drink a raft will be a necessity.
