
On-site supervision is available for students in the following categories:

- children whose parents cannot work from home and where no other supervision arrangements can be made (not only those defined as permitted workers)
- vulnerable children including:
 - children in out-of-home care
 - children deemed by Child Protection and/or Family Services to be at risk of harm
 - children identified by the school as vulnerable (including via referral from a family violence agency, homelessness or youth justice service or mental health or other health service).
- any child with a disability.

METHOD




Cut up zucchinis, onion and butter. Boil kettle and add 1 litre of water to chicken stock.



There has been a lot of work happening around the school recently in preparation for the students returning on site in Term 4.




The roof has been replaced on the student toilets. There will also be new toilets/urinal, lining and painting done to these facilities.
