GENERAL INFORMATION FOR EVERYONE

ILLNESS	<p>If your child is unwell with any of the following symptoms, please keep them home from school. Fever, runny nose, headaches, sore throat, fatigue.</p> <p>If we identify any of these symptoms at school, we will isolate your child and call you to take them home.</p> <p>Masks for students are recommended but not compulsory. If you wish for your child to wear them, please provide them with a mask</p> <p>Due to cases now in our region, please keep a very close eye on exposure sites and get tested and isolate your family when necessary.</p>
DRINK BOTTLES	<p>Remember student's need to bring a CLEARLY LABELLED drink bottle to school <u>each day</u>.</p> <p>Water is always available to students during the day via the bubble taps if students do not have their own drink bottle.</p>
HOT LUNCHES	<p>There is to be <u>no hot lunches at school until further notice</u>. This includes toasting sandwiches.</p>
BREAKFAST CLUB	<p>Breakfast Club will be running next week on Wednesday 13th and Friday 15th October from 8.40am – 8.55am. As we currently can't have anyone additional on-site, this will be run by staff.</p>

COVIDSafe Habits

- ▶ **Wash your hands** often with soap and running water for at least 20 seconds. Dry your hands with a paper towel or hand dryer.
- ▶ **Use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser** with over 60 per cent alcohol.
- ▶ **Cover your cough or sneeze** into your elbow.
- ▶ **Carry a face mask** with you when you leave home. Wearing a face mask is recommended when at a private gathering and outdoors when you can't keep 1.5 metres distance from other people.
- ▶ **You must wear a face mask** on public transport, in taxis, ride share vehicles, tour vehicles, at airports and during flights to and from Victoria.
- ▶ **Don't touch** your eyes, nose or mouth – or your face mask, if you're wearing one.
- ▶ **If you feel unwell** stay home. Call your GP or the Coronavirus (COVID-19) hotline on 1800 675 398 for advice.
- ▶ **Get tested** if you have COVID-19 symptoms. Go straight home and isolate while you wait for your results.
- ▶ **Remember**, if you're seeing friends and family – it's safer to meet outdoors.
- ▶ **Continue health habits**. Exercise, eat a balanced diet, get plenty of sleep and stay connected. Quit smoking (Quitline 137 848).
