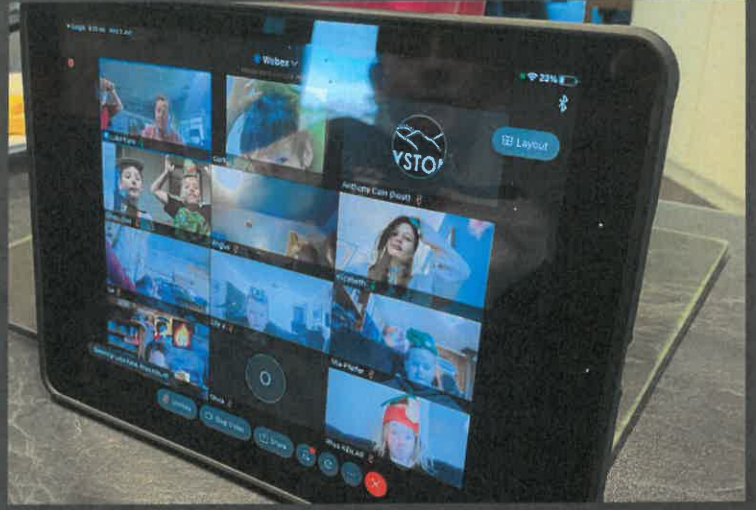
FAREWELL MR LUKE!

CIRCUIT-BREAKER LOCKDOWN

We are so happy and grateful to be able to return onsite to school today after the seven day circuit-breaker lockdown.

Thank you to all of our school families, students, teachers and staff for adapting so quickly and being so resilient during this time!

The Victorian Government has announced arrangements for schools in Victoria from and including Friday 4th June.

Based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, schools in regional Victoria will return to face-to-face learning for all students from and including Friday 4th June. This includes our school.

Face masks

Face masks are required to be worn outdoors at school where physical distancing of 1.5m cannot be maintained.

Children under 12 years of age and students at primary school are not required to wear face masks when at school. Face masks are mandatory for all school staff and school students aged 12 or older when travelling to and from school.

Today we welcomed Rhylee to Moyston PS in Grade 5!



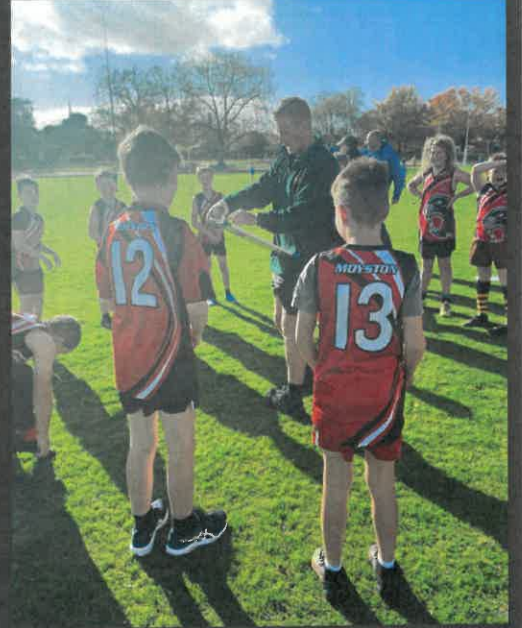
