This was a very successful evening for the school, after expenses we cleared almost **\$950!**

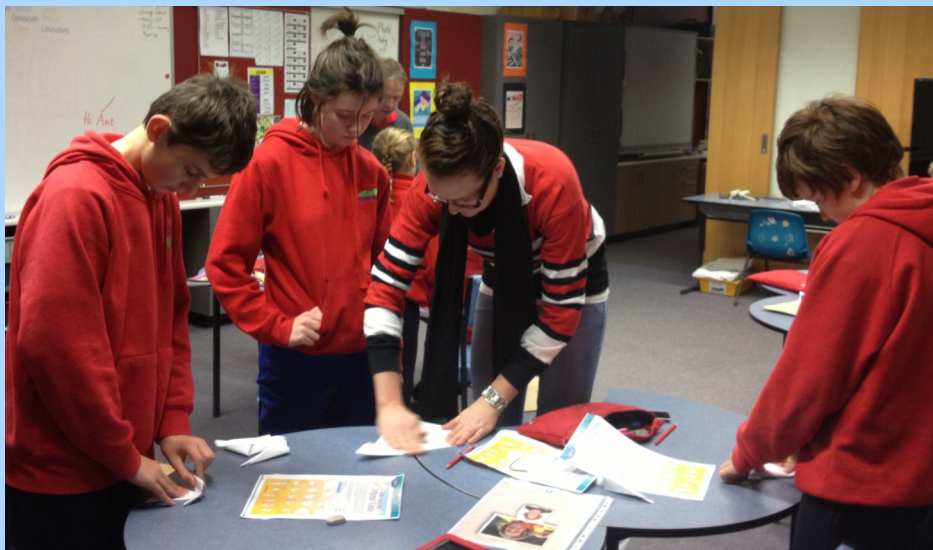
STUDENT TEACHERS
