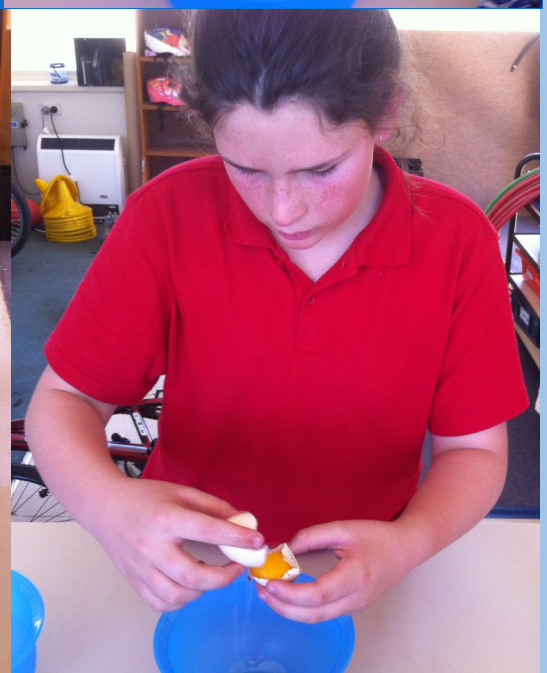
COOKING

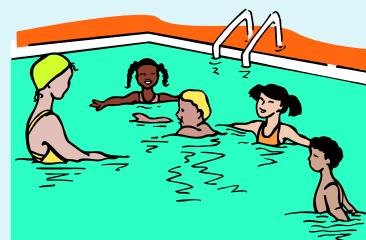
