










Senior









The senior and middle class students have been working very hard in preparation for the upcoming Science Fair next Friday 15th December at 2.30pm.


They have created detailed posters and prepared some amazing experiments to demonstrate to everyone who comes along to the Science Fair.
















Swimming

A reminder that there will be no Playgroup in January, our next Playgroup will be held


